**Superintendent Report: Dave Crews reported**

- VFD replacement  
Haynes Construction replaced the variable frequency drive in ERV one last week
- Valve Breakdown  
A valve in our boiler system released fluid from the water-cooling loop which created our system to shut off. Haynes came out and replaced the valve and added more glycol and water to the loop. We had an early release that day based on the lack of heat.
- Pump House Break  
We had a leak from the pipe that runs from the wall to the pump house. That kept us from pulling water from the well for two days. The pipe was fixed and we found that our sister holds enough water to run school for at least two days we did not have to cancel anything
