# PK-12 Principal Report: Jenna Crowder reported

- K-1 Bugs life spring concert is going on this evening and is the highlight of the spring.
- We have started a program called Catch my Breath. It is a program through BOCES to help inform students of the dangers of vaping. This program is taking place with 6th-12th graders.
- Pep rally assembly for boys' basketball this Thursday at 3:40 and next Thursday there will

be a pep rally for Knowledge bowl at 3:40

- CMAS/PSAT/SAT are scheduled for the weeks of April 7th-17th.
- We had our first growth mindset assembly on February 28th and we are looking forward to having more and really praising kids for showing grit and perseverance when things get hard while learning new content.
- We tried participating in an elementary fundraiser called School Store. This was a brandnew fundraiser to help get elementary classroom supplies, science kits, books etc. and I am happy to report that as of right now we have raised \$3,627.89 to put toward classroom materials for next year.
- I am currently working on the schedule for next year, we are trying to get to a place where we would have middle school athletics practice from 2:30-4:00, allowing for high school students to get in the gym immediately after school, hopefully helping with the gym situation. I am also working on the elementary schedule so that there is a common plan for K-2 and then 3-5 to allow for collaboration and data meetings.
- We are looking at a middle school math field trip to Dave and Busters in May, and a 3-5 CMAS field trip to the STEM science day and Colorado Rockies game at the end of April. We will get both of those itineraries to you during the April board meeting for approval.
- I am also working on getting evaluations done beginning of May, but am in constant contact with teachers about walkthroughs and what I am seeing.

- We have completed our 23/24 audit. It took a lot of effort to transition from our past auditors to our new auditors. We came away with a completed positive audit.
- Our waste water samples were not in compliance based on the lab results. The possible cause would be the draining of the propylene glycol.
