The responsibility for conducting the performance evaluation of the Superintendent rests exclusively with the Board (C.R.S. § 22-9-106(4)(b).) On February 10 the school board conducted an evaluation of the superintendent at a scheduled work session. They reviewed the standards of the superintendent.

The school board finds that the superintendent fully supports the Board of Education, its policies, and its governance and operates a district-level collaborative leadership system to guide the district by enacting the Board of Education's vision, policies, and academic directives.

The superintendent ensures every teacher in every subject area at every grade level has access to, or has the resources needed, to teach to the district prescribed curriculum aligned to current state standards. The superintendent works and supports the building administrators in their effort to effect school improvement throughout.

The superintendent continually works with the business manager to effectively allocate district resources which aligns with the district's academic and facilities improvement processes. The administration continues to analyze the budget through student count and other revenue resources to look at wage increases to stay competitive and be able to recruit and retain staff.

The school board directs the superintendent to continue to address the academic, curricular, budgetary, and facility needs of the school district. Use monthly meetings with the Superintendent to review concerns or observations and to celebrate accomplishments. If any issue involving the Superintendent's performance/progress occurs outside the formal evaluation process, discuss at a Board meeting (possibly executive session), and ask for comments from all Board members so the Superintendent has clear direction.
