

**SUPPLY LIST FOR CHEMISTRY or PHYSICS**

**Note:** If possible, please bring the following items with you on the first day of school. If any of these items poses a hardship for you and your family, please let me or the counselor know. From time-to-time students may be asked to bring additional materials for a class project/activity. These items will be kept to a minimum and at minimal cost.

- 3-ring binder (1½ - 2 inches wide) – 1 inch binders are too small ☺
- Set of 5 tab dividers (label “Notes”, “Homework”, “Labs”, “Tests”, and “Bellwork”)
- Loose-leaf paper **OR** notebook with **PERFORATED** pages; **NO REGULAR SPIRAL NOTEBOOKS, PLEASE!**
- Pencils – NO pens!
- Eraser(s), either on pencils or large one (ex. Pink Pearl or polymer type)
- **Scientific** calculator – I prefer Texas Instruments brand as they’re more user friendly than Casio (Ex. TI-30X IIB or similar type – Approx. \$12-15); **NOTE:** Calculator **MUST** have log & trig functions (sine, cosine, tangent) as well as exponent/scientific notation function. **If you need a scientific calculator for math or are purchasing a graphing calculator with these functions, you do NOT need to purchase another one!**
- A **JUMBO** book cover
- A package of 3 x 5 index cards (lined or unlined)
- Pair (reusable) or box of (disposable) latex or nitrile gloves – Chemistry only
- Set of fine-tipped markers, colored pencils, or crayons for use at home for occasional assignments – These may be left over from previous years, so if you have some at home there is no need to purchase additional ones.

**EXTRA CREDIT ITEMS – OPTIONAL**

- You may choose **ONE** of the following per quarter:  
Ream/package of copy paper, large box of quart or gallon Ziploc bags, package of EXPO dry erase markers (dark colors), package of dry erase erasers, paper towels, large box of Kleenex, canister of disinfecting wipes, package of sticky notes, hand sanitizer
